## Isaiah 2

<sup>2</sup> In the last days the mountain of the Lord's temple will be established as the highest of the mountains...and all nations will stream to it. <sup>3</sup> Many peoples will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the temple of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths." The law will go out from Zion, the word of the Lord from Jerusalem. <sup>4</sup> He will judge between the nations and will settle disputes for many peoples. They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore.

## Isaiah 60

<sup>1</sup> Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you...<sup>3</sup> Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn...<sup>5</sup> Then you will look and be radiant, your heart will throb and swell with joy; the wealth on the seas will be brought to you, to you the riches of the nations will come...<sup>11</sup> Foreigners will rebuild your walls, and their kings will serve you...<sup>12</sup> Your gates will always stand open, they will never be shut, day or night, so that people may bring you the wealth of the nations— their kings led in triumphal procession...<sup>14</sup> The children of your oppressors will come bowing before you; all who despise you will bow down at your feet and will call you the City of the LORD, Zion of the Holy One of Israel...<sup>18</sup> No longer will violence be heard in your land, nor ruin or destruction within your borders, but you will call your walls Salvation and your gates Praise. <sup>19</sup> The sun will no more be your light by day, nor will the brightness of the moon shine on you, for the LORD will be your everlasting light, and your God will be your glory. <sup>20</sup> Your sun will never set again, and your moon will wane no more; the LORD will be your everlasting light, and your days of sorrow will end. <sup>21</sup> Then all your people will be righteous and they will possess the land forever."

## Isaiah 11

<sup>6</sup> The wolf will live with the lamb,  
the leopard will lie down with the goat,  
the calf and the lion and the yearling together;  
and a little child will lead them.  
<sup>7</sup> The cow will feed with the bear,  
their young will lie down together,  
and the lion will eat straw like the ox.  
<sup>8</sup> The infant will play near the cobra's den,  
and the young child will put its hand into the  
viper's nest.  
<sup>9</sup> They will neither harm nor destroy  
on all my holy mountain,  
for the earth will be filled with the  
knowledge of the LORD as the waters cover the  
sea..

## Isaiah 65

<sup>23</sup> They will not labor in vain,  
nor will they bear children doomed to  
misfortune;  
for they will be a people blessed by the LORD,  
they and their descendants with them.  
<sup>24</sup> Before they call I will answer;  
while they are still speaking I will hear.  
<sup>25</sup> The wolf and the lamb will feed together,  
and the lion will eat straw like the ox,  
and dust will be the serpent's food.  
They will neither harm nor destroy  
on all my holy mountain,"

## Revelation 21

<sup>3</sup> And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. <sup>4</sup> 'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." <sup>5</sup> He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!"
