

Relief for a Troubled Heart

John 14

"Let not your heart be troubled" (14:1a)

"Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." (14:27)

The Solution:

"Believe in God, believe also in Me." (14:1b) NAS

"Believe": commit, entrust your well-being to; place your confidence in, trust

Further Assurances:

Peter asked, "Lord, why can not I follow You right now?" (13:37) NAS

"In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. "If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also". (14:2,3) NASU

Thomas said to him, "Lord, we don't know where You are going, so how can we know the way?" (14:5) NIV

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me. "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; from now on you know Him, and have seen Him." (14:6,7) NASU

Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us." (14:8) NIV

Jesus said to him, "Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?" (14:9) NASU

Judas (not Iscariot) said to Him, "Lord, how is it that You will manifest Yourself to us, and not to the world?" (14:22) NKJV

Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode with him." (14:23) NASU
