<p>Colossians 1:22</p> <p>But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation— NIV</p>	<p>Colossians 3:6,7</p> <p>Therefore, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your life in him, rooted and built up in him and firm in your faith just as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. NET</p>
<p>Colossians 2:9,10</p> <p>For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority. NIV</p>	<p>Colossians 3:1-3</p> <p>Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. NIV</p>
